Evaluation Results Summary

Training seminar participants were asked to complete an evaluation of the seminar. There were 119 participants and 10 speakers. A total of 49 participants (41 percent) filled out evaluation forms. *Table 1* outlines the participants who completed evaluations by their profession.

The rating scale used in this evaluation summary was 1=poor, 2=good, 3=very good, and 4=excellent. Participants rated the training overall an average rating of 3.33. The average rating of seminar materials was 3.52. Participants rated hotel accommodations an average of 3.33. Therefore, these aspects of the training seminar were rated very good to excellent.

The highest rated speaker was Steve Chalke with 3.70 and the lowest rated presentation was 2.96. All speakers were rated good to excellent. *Table 2* indicates the ratings of for each of the presentations.
